THE CHASE AT PGA GOLF CLUB COYOTE SPRINGS NAMED AMONG TOP 10 BEST NEW COURSES IN THE WORLD FOR 2008 BY T&L GOLF

COYOTE SPRINGS, Nev. – The Chase, a Jack Nicklaus Signature Course at PGA Golf Club Coyote Springs™, has been named among 2008's Top 10 Best New Golf Courses by the editors of Travel & Leisure Golf, one of the golf industry's leading consumer publications. The announcement was made in the publication's November/December 2008 issue and honors the top 10 best new golf courses from around the world.

"This is a tremendous honor for our entire team and we are deeply humbled by it," said Harvey Whittemore, chairman and founder of Wingfield Nevada Group, developer of Coyote Springs through its affiliate Coyote Springs Land Development Corporation. "Given the quality of the other courses honored as well as T&L Golf's reputation as one of the most widely read publications among accomplished players, this recognition is a great source of pride. It also gives us a strong sense that our commitment to providing guests with one of the very best golf experiences in the world is well placed."

Other golf courses honored on the list of Best New Courses include The Castle Course in St Andrews, Scotland; Tetherow Golf Club in Bend, Oregon; and The Legacy Course at Roco Ki in Punta Cana, Dominican Republic.

Opened for daily fee play in May 2008, The Chase at PGA Golf Club Coyote Springs is located 50 minutes northeast of the Las Vegas Strip off US Highway 93, and is part of a 43,000-acre master-planned community currently under development by Coyote Springs Land Development Corporation.

PGA Golf Club Coyote Springs is the first new golf course to open in the Las Vegas area in more than six years. PGA Golf Club Coyote Springs will be part of the larger, soon-to-be-built PGA Village at Coyote Springs – a mix of golf-themed retail, instruction and hospitality venues and the western home for PGA members

The Chase is a par-72 Nicklaus Signature Course that measures 7,471 yards from the Black or Championship tees (75.8 rating, 141 slope), 6,807 yards from the Blue tees (72.0/137), 6,268 yards from the White tees (69.7/132) and 5,349 yards from the Red or forward tees. The

golf course has 11 water features, including one with a massive five-tier waterfall. Fairways, tees and rough are grassed in common rye grass, while greens are bent grass. Green complexes are fortified by deep, white-sand bunkers and feature plenty of movement and plateaus that are ripe for strategic pin placements.

Located in one of the most dramatically beautiful regions of Southern Nevada, PGA Golf Club Coyote Springs is about a one hour drive from Las Vegas, free from the hustle and bustle of The Strip. Cradled between the Mojave Desert and the Great Basin, Coyote Springs is located at the intersection of US 93 and State Route 168. From Las Vegas take I-15 north to US 93, and follow US 93 north to State Route 168.
